Hello,

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) conducts program audits annually to evaluate sponsoring organizations' compliance with core Medicare Part C and Part D program requirements. CMS pays particular attention to those requirements that safeguard beneficiaries' access to medically necessary services and prescription drugs. This includes clinical decision making, timely notification of decisions, proper classification of beneficiary requests, appropriate administration or Gateway's formulary, timely effectuation of approved drugs and services, and so much more.

With the recent release of the CMS 2015 Program Audit Process and Protocol Updates, I want to share some pertinent information with you. As First Tier, Downstream, and Related Entities (FDRs) that have been delegated to perform core functions for Gateway HealthSM Medicare products, it is important that you review and understand this information. If Gateway Health is selected for an audit, we will need to work with many of you to obtain the required information in order to satisfy CMS requirements and facilitate a successful audit.

This year, CMS will audit the following core program areas:

- Part C and Part D Compliance Program Effectiveness (CPE)
- Part C Organization Determinations, Appeals, and Grievances (ODAG)
- Part D Coverage Determinations, Appeals, and Grievances (CDAG)
- Part D Formulary and Benefit Administration (FA)
- Special Needs Plans Model of Care (SNP-MOC)

Additionally, CMS has added two pilot program areas, which include:

- Medication Therapy Management
- Provider Network Adequacy

I have attached CMS's memo regarding changes to the 2015 audit process for your review. Over the next few months, these communications will focus on the CMS Audit Process, as well as common findings that CMS observed during the 2014 Program Audit Cycle.
