HOW TO MAKE A FACE MASK Lima Memorial



Materials Needed:

9" x 6" cotton fabric. (Remember, these will be worn by men and women) 9" x 6" cotton flannel for the backing, if available; otherwise use cotton fabric Rope elastic, beading cord elastic or 1/8" flat elastic

- 1. Cut the elastic 7" long, and tie a knot at each end (DO NOT knot the ends of the flat).
- 2. Put right sides of cotton fabric together.
- 3. Starting at the center of bottom edge, sew to the first corner and stop. Sew the elastic with the knot out into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this.
- 4. Sew to the next corner, and stop. Bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner, and sew a few stitches forward and back.
- 5. Sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Again, put an elastic with the knot out.
- 6. Sew to next corner, and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
- 7. Sew across the bottom, leaving about 1.5" to 2" open.
- 8. Cut the thread.
- 9. Turn inside out.
- 10. Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction.
- 11. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.

Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally.
